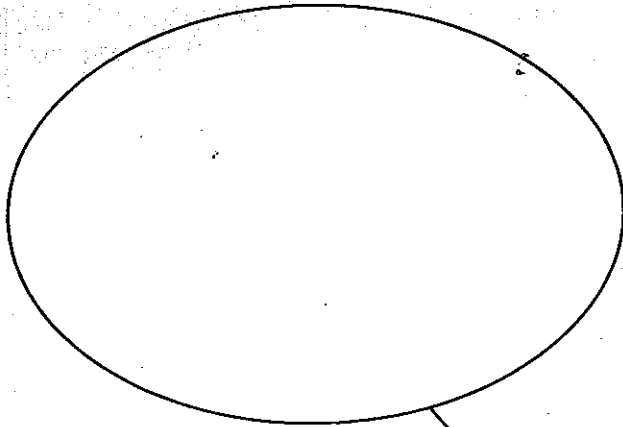


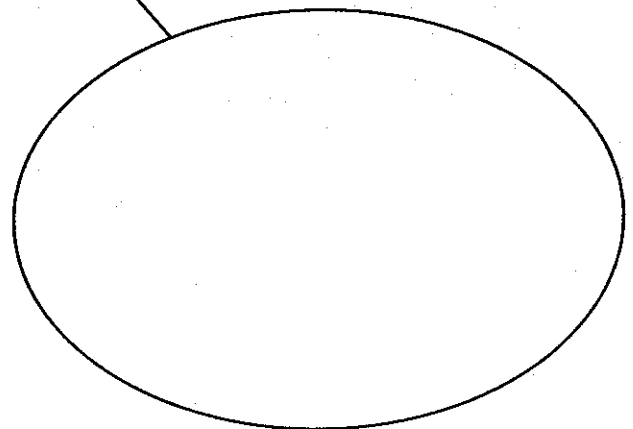
Fueling the Fire
